### **Parking on University of Washington Campus**

**Recommended parking lot for Getting to Zero is Padelford Parking Garage** (accessed from Pend Oreille Road off Montlake Blvd NE). **All guests must stop at a campus gatehouse** to purchase a permit and receive directions to their destination. Please say that you are here for “Getting to Zero” at the gatehouse and they will be able to direct you.

Limited parking is available for visitors on campus; carpooling is strongly encouraged. Parking fees are charged daily, Monday through Friday, and on Saturday from 7 am to noon. Rates are subject to change without advance notice. Parking fees are payable upon entrance to the campus. Recreational campers and trailers are not permitted to park in UW parking lots.

### **Directions to Padelford Garage from Interstate 5**

- From I-5 North or South: Exit onto NE 45th Street.
- Head East on NE 45th Street. Go about 8 blocks and Turn Right onto Memorial Drive.
- Stop at the Gate House.
- Turn Left onto Stevens Way and follow Stevens Way through campus.
- At the 4-Way stop turn left onto Pend Orielle.
- At the next 4-Way stop turn right into Padelford Garage.
- Park as directed.

### **Directions to Padelford Garage from WA State Route 520**

- Take the Montlake Avenue Exit.
- Stay in right lane and go straight through several lights.
- Once you pass Husky Stadium – move into the center lane. Stay left.
- Take a left onto Pend Orielle (East entrance to campus).
- Stop at the Gate House.
- Park as directed.

### ***Mobility Impaired? Self-Identify at Gatehouse for Disability Parking for Visitors***

*Upon entering campus at any gatehouse, a visitor who is mobility impaired should self-identify that they need close parking in order to be accommodated. Visitors will be assigned parking in an area as close to their destination as possible. ASK FOR PARKING IN LOT N6/N7 ACROSS FROM HAGGETT/MCMAHON HALLS.*

### **Walking from Padelford Garage to Haggett Hall**

*Note: it is a bit of a walk from the parking garage to the venue; please consider this when choosing footwear for the event!*

- Take the Padelford escalators to Stevens Way. (or walk up Pend Orielle to the four-way stop).
- Turn Right onto Stevens Way (go about 25 yards).
- Immediate right onto Whitman Court.
- Haggett is the second dormitory on the right (just past McMahan Hall).
- Enter the main doors and go down the hall to stairs/elevator (located to the right (south)).
- Go down the stairs or elevator and enter the double doors into the South Cascade Room.

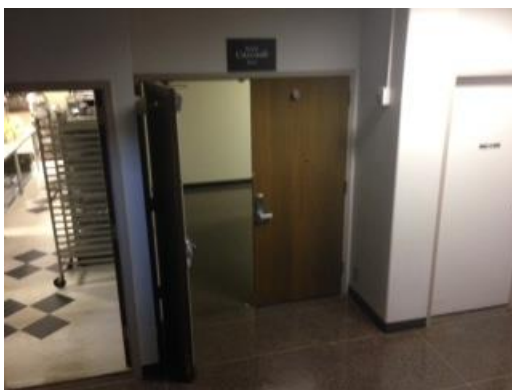

**Students will be at the front desk beginning at 8:00 am to help direct you to the Cascade Room**



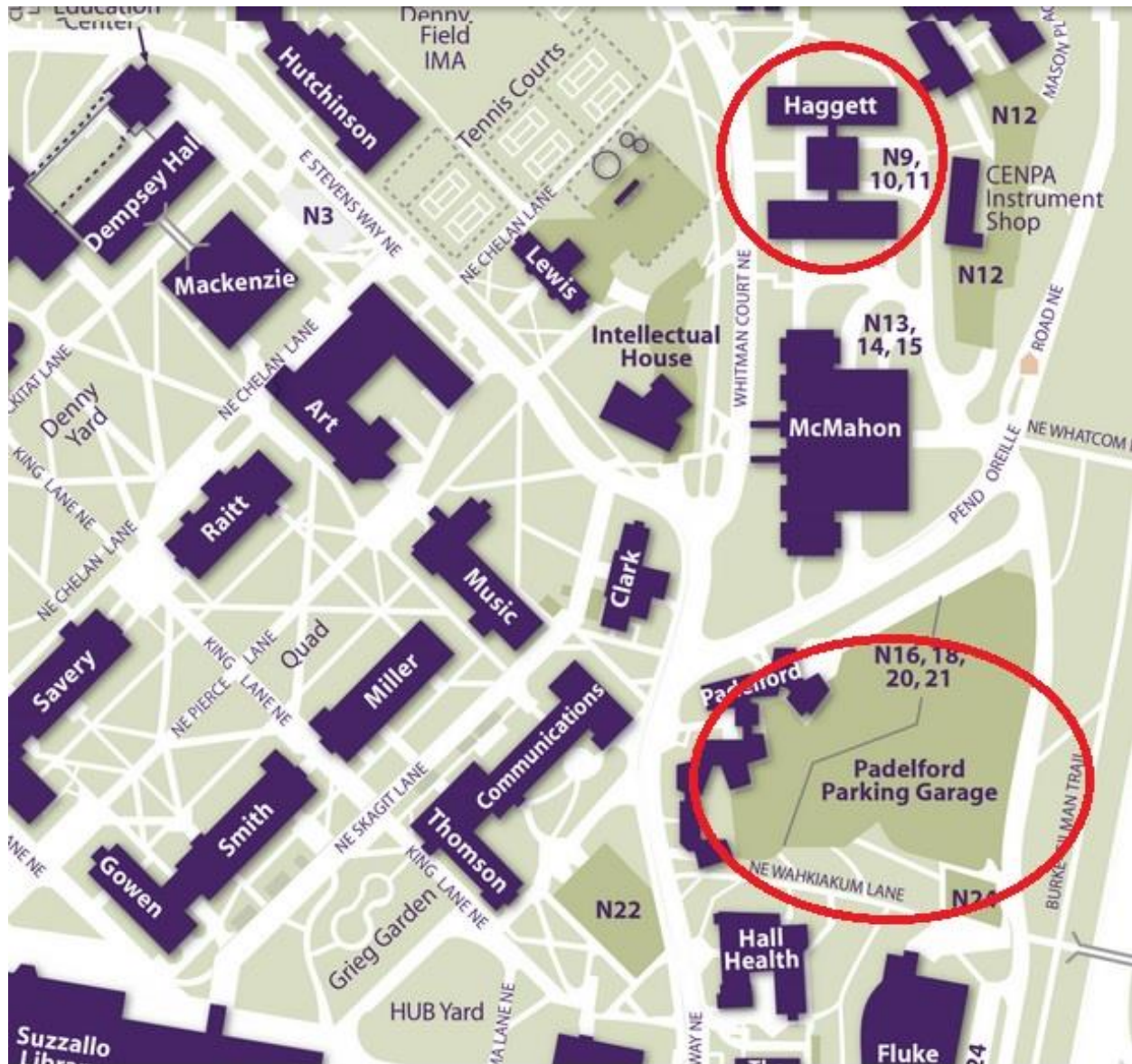
**South Cascade Room Entrance from stairs**
