Call for Presentations for the December 15 full-day education event



AIA Seattle seeks compelling proposals to present at this year's Building Envelope Forum, Tuesday, December 15 at the Mountaineers Seattle Program Center.

This year's full day forum will focus on what's happened so far in building envelope design, how that is defining where the field is headed, and the consequences of current regulations, codes, policies, and practices in building design. The program will include diverse perspectives in the creation and implementation of high-performance building enclosures and highlight opportunities for new approaches and innovation in future delivery methods.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA + PROGRAM STRUCTURE**

The AIA Seattle 2015 Building Envelope Forum Planning Task Force will use the criteria below as a foundation for selecting proposals to present at this year's forum.

Proposal clearly identifies what will occur in the session in the format and time allotted

Proposal describes how the session will effectively engage the audience in innovative thinking about new or proven ideas and approaches

Proposal explains how the session will inform ACE professionals about proven practices, push the leading edge of building envelopes, and/or motivate the pursuit excellence

Proposal raises important questions or delivers positive, solution-oriented outcomes

Proposal demonstrates how the session fits the overall forum description and sub-topics
