At the national level, he is a voting member of the ASHRAE 90.1 Committee and serves as Chair of the IECC Commercial Energy Code Consensus Committee for development of the 2024 IECC. Prior to taking his position at the City of Seattle, Duane was a principal at NBBJ, with 30 years' experience designing complex projects as a technical architect. He is a featured speaker nationally on issues of energy efficiency and energy regulations, and in 2016 was elected to the American Institute of Architects College of Fellows.

Judy Tucker, AIA, Principal, Form + Function Architecture | Judy has a career's worth of code-related experience as former co-chair and current member of AIA Seattle's Code Committee and current/long term member of CCAB (Seattle Construction Code Advisory Committee).
