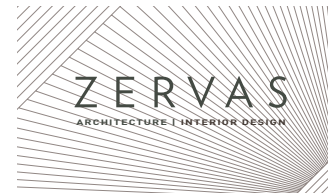

2021 Design Awards Distinguished Jurors

Dr. Sharon Egretta Sutton, FAIA | Parsons School of Design



Dr. Sharon Egretta Sutton, FAIA is distinguished visiting professor at Parsons School of Design and has also served on the faculties of Columbia University, Pratt Institute, the University of Cincinnati, the University of Michigan, and the University of Washington. The twelfth African American woman in the United States to be licensed to practice architecture, the first to be promoted to full professor of architecture, and the second to be elected a fellow in the American Institute of Architects, Dr. Sutton's scholarship explores America's continuing struggle for racial justice. Her book, *When Ivory Towers Were Black*, describes the nation's boldest recruitment of minority architecture and planning students during the Civil Rights Movement. An upcoming book, *A Pedagogy of Hope*, shows how low-income, youth of color can change a racist, consumerist society by transforming their surroundings.

Dr. Sutton is a distinguished professor of the Association of Collegiate Schools of Architecture and served as president of the National Architectural Accrediting Board. She received the Whitney M. Young Jr. Award from the American Institute of Architects, the Medal of Honor from both the New York and Seattle chapters of that organization, and the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Michigan Women's Hall of Fame.

Rik Allen | Artist



Rik's earliest and formative glass studio experiences and education came as a studio assistant in Providence, working with a number of wonderful artists, Daniel Clayman, James Watkins, and Michael Scheiner. He earned a BA in Anthropology from Franklin Pierce University. In 1994, Rik relocated to Washington

where he joined the William Morris team at the Pilchuck Glass School for thirteen years.

Rik has had numerous solo exhibitions of his sculptures throughout the country, including the Science Fiction Museum and Hall of Fame, the Museum of Northwest Art, Traver Gallery, Blue Rain Gallery, Schantz Gallery, and Duncan McClellan Gallery. His sculptures have been acquired for a number of public and private collections, including the Museum of Glass in Tacoma, Imagine Museum and Toyama Institute of Glass, Blue Origin, Boeing, Amazon, and SpaceX. In 2018 Rik was awarded the "Grand Artist of the future" Award by the Imagine Museum. Rik and his wife, Shelley Muzykowski, work from their beautiful rural home and studio in Skagit County Washington.
