Strategic Support

The Member Engagement Steering Committee supports AIA Seattle member committees to provide a space to support the interests, professional goals, learning and connection for all types of members. The Steering Committee develops and implements tools and structures for member engagement through committees.

Stewardship and Guidance

The Steering Committee evaluates ongoing committee activities and develops tools and resources to align committee activities with the chapter's Mission + Vision + Values. The Steering Committee encourages committees to create relevant programming for all members. The Steering Committee collaborates with the Professional Practice Steering Committee, who implement the tools created by the Member Engagement Steering Committee to support content specific driven member committees.

Individual Expectations

Member Engagement Steering Committee members serve as ambassadors for the organization who share opportunities for engagement with their network. Steering Committee members attend monthly meetings to conceive, plan, and execute activities in support of member committees.

Each Steering Committee member serves as a liaison to at least one member committee, evaluating committee activities through the Annual Plan process. Member Engagement Steering Committee members are required to communicate with their assigned committees quarterly, provide support and recommendations to execute their respective committee purpose, and foster connections between committees.
